What is Oak Bridge Academy?	Oak Bridge is Chico Unified School District's newest school. As part of the district's Oakdale Independent Study Program, we offer:
	 a fully accredited, university-prep., online learning option for students in 6th through 12th grades as well as
	 a traditional independent study program for kindergarten through fifth grade students.
	Oak Bridge Academy, located inside the Chico Mall, is staffed by highly qualified teachers, available to assist students with coursework, career and college planning.
Does Oak Bridge offer Advanced Placement courses?	In addition to our online courses fulfilling A-G requirements for the CSU and UC systems, there are several Honors level and AP courses available in our curriculum. Students residing in the CUSD attendance boundaries are also welcome to take AP and IB courses that are offered at Chico High and Pleasant Valley High.
Is it possible for students to take classes through Oak Bridge AND Butte College or Chico State at the same time?	The flexibility of online education affords students opportunities to take classes that are offered at each of our area's post-secondary schools. Some of the courses offered at these institutions "count" toward high school graduation, and many allow students to accelerate their education by earning college credits while being simultaneously enrolled in high school.
	Students interested in concurrent enrollment opportunities should visit <u>Butte College</u> for additional information. Admissions requirements for Chico State's <u>Scholars Program</u> may also be of interest to students who qualify.
Are Chico students enrolled in Oak Bridge allowed to take classes at other Chico Unified schools?	Oak Bridge students may also take classes at Chico High and Pleasant Valley High. Both comprehensive high schools have award-winning Career and Technical (CTE) programs and highly regarded Music and Arts programs; we want Chico Unified students to have the best education they can find to fit their needs and interests.





May students take online classes through Oak Bridge AND be	Students may participate in athletics at the CUSD high schools. Students living in the Chico High attendance area
involved in high school athletics in the Chico Unified School District?	may play sports for Chico High, and those living in the Pleasant Valley area may play at Pleasant Valley.
Can students living outside the Chico Unified School District attendance boundaries enroll in online classes at Oak Bridge?	Students residing outside of CUSD attendance boundaries may enroll full time at Oak Bridge. The enrollment process proceeds just as it would if an out-of-area student was leaving one school to attend another in Chico.
Is an Oak Bridge student who lives outside of Chico allowed to be involved in Chico Unified high school athletics?	Students must reside within the CUSD attendance boundaries to have access to athletic programs at Chico and Pleasant Valley High Schools.
